Notes from the Continuing Clergy meeting on 30Sept23

- 1. Our Diocesan Bishop is the pastor of the church. The parish priest is his representative. Order of Chain of Command 1. Diocesan Bishop
 - 2. Chancellor 3. Dean 4. Parish Priest

2. <u>Liturgical Services</u>

- a. Saturday Nights Vespers or Eves of Feasts will soon become a vigil: Great Vespers and Matins
- b. Lenten Services: Wednesday Evening Presanctified; Friday Morning Presanctified; Friday Evening Compline with Akathist to the Theotokos; Saturday Memorial Liturgy
- c. Holy Week: (services are not to be abbreviated)
 - i. Bridegroom Matins (evenings): Palm Sunday; Holy Monday, Tuesday, & Wednesday
 - ii. Presanctified (mornings): Holy Monday, Tuesday, & Wednesday
 - iii. Holy Unction: Holy Wednesday Evening (preferred with multiple priests)
 - iv. Holy Thursday: Morning Vesperal Liturgy preparation of reserved sacraments); Evening Matins with passions gospel
 - v. Holy Friday: Morning Royal Hours; Afternoon Vespers w/carrying out of the Shroud; Evening Matins w/Lamentations and procession of the Shroud
 - vi. Holy Saturday: Morning Vesperal Liturgy; Late Night **Beginning of Pascha**

d. Mystery of Penance (Confession) (OCA Guidelines pg 17)

i. The priest, as the confessor for the flock entrusted to his care, determines the frequency with which his spiritual children confess their sins, with monthly confession as the norm. If a parishioner desires to seek confession elsewhere it must be done with the blessing of the parish priest. OCA GUIDELINES states confession should be done on a monthly basis however, His Eminence has reiterated that confession is not driven by time but the need to confess. Some may need it weekly and some not so much but minimally 8 times a year.

- ii. NO GENERAL CONFESSION; NO ABSOLUTION W/O CONFESSION
- iii. Unction can be done as much as possible for someone battling a disease or sickness for months or even years. Order of unction: Confession, Communion, Unction

f. <u>Baptisms/Receptions of Converts</u> (OCA Guidelines pp 15-17)

- i. Exorcism nor any prayers can be shortened or omitted
- ii. Partaking of communion as soon as possible after baptism
- iii. Godparents/Sponsors are those who live a full liturgical life committed as an Orthodox Christian and receive Communion and Confession regularly. Sponsors must provide baptismal certificate. NO HONORARY SPONSORS
- iv. ALL CONVERTS WILL BE RECEIVED BY BAPTISM. ONLY HIS EMINENCE CAN DIRECT OTHERWISE.
- v. CATECHISM IS TO BE ONE YEAR

g. Marriages (OCA Guidelines pg 19)

- i. Pre Marriage Counseling is required before setting a date to be married. Date of marriage must be set within the liturgical allowance.
- ii. Birth certificate and baptismal certificate are required documents for petition to be wed to include civil license for the day of the wedding. Sponsors as well
- iii. If an Orthodox Christian is married outside the church they are barred from the chalice.
- iv. No crowning service of those already married.
- v. One Counseling session required at three months post marriage

h. Receive guidance from the bishop in all matters.
